## Matthew 7:7

Many are running here and there seeking counseling from psychics, fortunetellers, palm readers, tarot card readers, and spiritualists. They're in worse shape now than when they first started seeking because they

## Deuteronomy 18:10

There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass (burned as an offering to an idol) through the fire or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter or a witch, or a charmer or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.

Many Christians are in trouble spiritually because they're seeking other gods that can't help or deliver them from their dilemma. ### Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil (calamity) to give you an expected end.

## Matthew 21:22 And all things, whatsoever ye

There is nothing you can be bound by that God can't set you free from it, but you have to want to be set free. God will never overstep your will. No matter what you do, it will not stop God from loving you, but it will stop Him from being your Father, sin brings a disconnection as it did in the Garden of Eden with Adam and Eve.

Too many times, people will believe just because God loves you, He will not discipline or He will not allow one to die and go to hell. If that's the path the person chose, God loves them enough to allow them to send themselves to Hell. He didn't place them there, they chose for themselves to go there. He has made us free-will agents, we chose where we will spend eternity. We can't fault God for our behavior and the consequences of our behavior.

Just as God delivered the children out of Egypt, He can deliver you from your Egypt, if you allow Him. God will give you peace that will surpass all human understanding, no matter what you're going through when you have the Son of God dwelling in your being. If you're in need of deliverance, God will deliver you from people,

things and places you can't deliver yourself from. You will not have to attend a twelve step plan or try to avenge yourself, let God be your deliverer!

## John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled neither let it be afraid.
